Academic Strides:

1st – 5th July: Dr. Harsh Gupta, along with his colleague from Mumbai Dr. Arpit Sharma, attended 10th international summer school at the university of Brescia in Italy from the 1st-5th July 2024.

It comprised of 3 days of cadaver dissection and 2 days of live surgeries.

The course was aimed to highlight the surgeries of the anterior skull base and was attended by delegates from all over the globe.

Interesting Cases:


COCHLEAR IMPLANT:

A high-end cochlear implant surgery was performed by Dr Harsh independently. Dr Gauri and Dr Harsh are now routinely performing cochlear surgeries independently. Even adult cochlear implant has been performed successfully and “switch on” for the patient gave good response.



TRACHEAL STENOSIS:

A young boy developed tracheal stenosis as he was on ventilator following surgery for VSD. Subsequently after tracheostomy tube was removed he experienced respiratory distress. The patient consulted in Mumbai where he was advised open surgery. On airway assessment we found that there was narrowing at the level of vocal cords and rest of the airway was normal. Kashima procedure was performed on this patient and airway restored.



ORAL MALIGNANCY WITH CORONARY ARTERY DISEASE:

A middle aged male patient had to undergo surgery for Ca Lip, Mandibulectomy, Neck Dissection and Reconstruction. On Pre Anesthesia Evaluation the patient was found to have significant narrowing of coronary arteries, requiring CABG for the patient to be fit for cancer surgery. But in that case cancer surgery would have to be postponed by at least 3 months. The patient was operated at a cardiac centre where CABG was done and in same sitting immediately cancer surgery was performed. The patient recovered without any complications.



TONGUE CANCER SURGERY WITH MULTIPLE MEDICAL CO MORBIDITIES:

A 65-year lady had to undergo surgery for Ca tongue with neck dissection. She had H/O Hypertension, Diabetes, Asthma and Cardiac Failure. The patient would get breathless even after walking few steps. With thorough cardiac evaluation and due care the patient underwent successful surgery and made smooth post operative recovery.

BLS Training Programme. ISA Nagpur conducted BLS and CPR training for staff of Neeti Clinics. All staff members got hands on experience on the CPR mannequin.
